

# **Community Champion**

## Overview

**Healthwatch Manchester** is a not-for-profit, independent organisation here to champion the rights of people involved with and affected by health and social care services in Manchester. We are here to give these people a powerful voice so they will be heard by those who plan, run and regulate services and who have the power to influence and improve these services across Manchester.

### What we expect from you:

At Healthwatch Manchester we expect our Community Champion to work directly with local and peer support groups to identify issues faced by different communities when accessing health or care services in Manchester.

#### What does the role entail:

The role is extremely diverse and encompasses a range of activities such as:

- Identifying and developing a relationship with hard to reach communities and peer support groups
- Building a close working relationship with a host organisation
- Attending offsite meetings on an ad-hoc basis
- Providing a focal point for people within these groups to discuss their problems free from judgement
- Summarising and documenting feedback on health care or social services
- Identifying and analyzing trends from the information collected
- Writing and compiling research reports
- Signposting people to the appropriate health or support services to obtain the necessary support that they need
- Conveying to local communities what Healthwatch does, our research work and our current projects

#### How long will the role last:
